











































Cut mums are a great fall crop for extended sales after dahlia season ends.



Basic Growing Instructions

- Plants should be grown in a high tunnel for protection from frost when they are at their peak bloom.
- Northern growers with early cold weather may want to use the Early varieties.
- Plants should be planted upon arrival.
- Pinch the plants three weeks after planting, around July 5th, leaving six leaf nodes, resulting in six stems per plant.
- Early, Mid, or Late bloom time is listed on each photo.

Early varieties that start blooming Oct 19 -21

Mid varieties that start blooming Oct 24 - 30

Late varieties start blooming Nov 3 - 8

(Based on Zone 6b, SW Virginia)

- Space two plants per sq foot.
- Support netting is required.
- Fertilize with 20-10-20 At 200ppm N
- Scout for aphids and white flies. Treat as needed.
- Side disbudding is not required, but will produce one large bloom on double flowered varieties, especially with Shanghai Red and Golden Gate.

NOTE: All varieties are Patented. Propagation is prohibited. Growers may not root additional cuttings.
