(Lomandra confertifolia ssp rubiginosa)

Propagation

Not Applicable. Growing On to Finish

Media

Use a well-drained, disease-free, soilless media with a pH of 5.5 to 6.2 and a medium initial nutrient charge (EC 0.75 mmhos/cm).

Temperature

Nights: 60 to 64°F or warmer (16 to 18°C)

Days: 66 to 74°F or warmer (19 to 23°C)

Light

Full sun. Maintain light levels as high as possible while maintaining temperature.

Irrigation Allow the media to dry between waterings.

Fertilizer

Apply 100 ppm N once a week. Overfeeding results in less upright plants.

Growth Regulators

No need to reduce growth rate or size.

Pinching

None.

Spacing Can be grown pot tight.

Crop Scheduling Transplant to saleable # 1 container: 6 months

Container Size 1-gallon (18-cm) pot: 1 plant per pot

General Recommendations

Ornamental grasses prefer being grown on the dry side with low feed. Growing them too wet or with too

much feed will tend to make them less upright.
